Our History

At Ronald McDonald House Charities of Kansas City (RMHC-KC), we keep families with sick children close to each other and the care and resources they need. At our three Houses adjacent to Children's Mercy Hospital and Ronald McDonald Family Room, we create places of respite where families can rally around and support one another.

On any given night, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Kansas City (RMHC-KC) serves 91 families.

RMHC-KC alleviates the worry and expense of finding a close, comfortable and affordable place for a family to stay while their child receives the medical care they need. That can make a world of difference to a child bravely battling an illness or recovering from a serious injury.

Our mission at Ronald McDonald House Charities is to reduce the burden of childhood illness on children and their families. We accomplish this by:

- Creating a caring and uplifting environment
- Providing comfortable lodging convenient to a health facility
- Undertaking resource and fund development activities that support our facilities, programs and services

Facts about RMHC-KC

- We serve families whose children are receiving treatment for serious illness (like pediatric cancer, organ transplants, babies in the NICU, emergency situations and complex surgeries).
- We have 91 rooms to host families, in a typical year we are full nearly every night.
- Families do not pay to stay here, we rely on the community to help keep us going and open. It costs us \$100 to host a family for a night.
- We are a local 501c3 organization, every dollar stays in KC to support this important work.
- In addition to a room, we provide meals, transportation, hygiene products, clothing and most any other basic need items while a family is with us.
- Some families are here for a few nights, and some are here for months at a time (had a family go home earlier this year that was with us for a year). As long as you need us, we'll be here.



Lettie Jude was born on October 27 in Springfield, Mo., after a normal, healthy pregnancy. Just hours after being born, doctors discovered Lettie's heart was not working correctly, despite testing done through her mom, Haiden's, pregnancy. The left ventricle was not pumping oxygen to the rest of her body.

"Not hearing your baby cry for over 10 minutes is pretty rough ... we never did hear her cry in the delivery room," first-time mom Haiden said.

Lettie was rushed to Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City at less than 24 hours old. Lettie's mom and dad, Jordan, found their home in Kansas City at Ronald McDonald House Charities.

"You walk in the doors and you feel love," Haiden said.

The family was given a suite so Lettie's grandmothers could stay to help out the new parents. After a month at Children's Mercy, Lettie's heart function was declining and she was put on the transplant list. At just 5 weeks old Lettie had her first open-heart surgery to install a device to keep her heart pumping until she received a transplant.

"RMHC-KC has been a HUGE blessing to our family," Haiden said. "We get to spend time with our daughter and not worry about the finances of paying for a hotel or for food – we would have had very little left for her medical bills."

On March 3, Jordan and Haiden got the call they had been waiting for. Lettie had a perfect match for her little heart, and she would be receiving her transplant the next day, on her 100th day on the transplant list. The transplant went perfectly for 9.5-pound Lettie Jude, and it has since been a smooth recovery. They hope to be discharged to go to her KC "home" at Ronald McDonald House Charities this month, so Lettie will be close for monitoring and checkups.

"The Ronald McDonald House has become our home. We are so used to it now ... we are so grateful for it," Haiden said.

The Rau family will stay at RMHC-KC together and will go home for the first time in early summer if all goes as planned.

"Though our situation was shocking and unexpected, it is so comforting to have a place to live so close to our daughter for the months to come."

If you've collected items, they can be delivered to the Longfellow House (2502 Cherry St, KC MO) between the hours of 7am -7pm daily.

In order to keep everyone safe during these times, we ask that you leave donations on the table outside and text us at 816-239-5759 or ring the doorbell to let us know you've arrived. Staff will come out to retrieve the items. There is no entry from outside visitors due to Covid-19 restrictions at this time.
