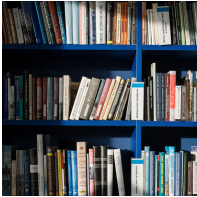

Our History

At Ronald McDonald House Charities of Kansas City (RMHC-KC), we keep families with sick children close to each other and the care and resources they need. At our three Houses adjacent to Children's Mercy Hospital and Ronald McDonald Family Room, we create places of respite where families can rally around and support one another.

On any given night, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Kansas City (RMHC-KC) serves 91 families.

RMHC-KC alleviates the worry and expense of finding a close, comfortable and affordable place for a family to stay while their child receives the medical care they need. That can make a world of difference to a child bravely battling an illness or recovering from a serious injury.

Our mission at Ronald McDonald House Charities is to reduce the burden of childhood illness on children and their families. We accomplish this by:

- Creating a caring and uplifting environment
- Providing comfortable lodging convenient to a health facility
- Undertaking resource and fund development activities that support our facilities, programs and services

Are you wanting to host a fundraiser but aren't sure where to start? Here are some fun ways to raise money.

- **RUN, WALK, SWIM or CYCLE** - find a local race in your area, challenge a friend or coworker to complete it with you and participate in the event in honor of a family or child at Ronald McDonald House.
- **CELEBRATE** - Getting married? Turning a year older? Ask family and friends to donate to RMHC-KC in lieu of gifts. You can easily host a fundraiser for us on Facebook!
- **PLAY** - organize a golf outing, bowling tournament or karaoke night and ask for donations to participate, or in attendance, at the event.
- **JEANS DAY** - ask your coworkers to make a donation in exchange for wearing jeans to work
- **WATCH PARTY** - turn a football or Bachelor night watch party into a fundraiser. Host your friends for a watch party and donate the proceeds to your fundraising goal

Facts about RMHC-KC

- We serve families whose children are receiving treatment for serious illness (like pediatric cancer, organ transplants, babies in the NICU, emergency situations and complex surgeries).
- We have 91 rooms to host families and we are full nearly every night.
- Families do not pay to stay here, we rely on the community to help keep us going and open. It costs us \$100 to host a family for a night.
- We are a local 501c3 organization, every dollar stays in KC to support this important work.
- In addition to a room, we provide meals, transportation, hygiene products, clothing and most any other basic need items while a family is with us.
- Some families are here for a few nights, and some are here for months at a time (had a family go home earlier this year that was with us for a year). As long as you need us, we'll be here.



MEET THE MEYER FAMILY

A new lump on 5-year-old Cheviona "Chevi" Meyer's face changed her family's life forever. Her bump rapidly grew to golf ball-sized, and they received a diagnosis for stage 4 rhabdomyosarcoma. This type of cancer spreads so quickly that it had spread to her lymph nodes and her lungs in the month and a half since they noticed it.

Green Ridge, Mo., residents Destiny, Chevi and Chevi's brother, Ryder, stayed at the Ronald McDonald House on and off for surgeries and big doses of chemo at Children's Mercy, but stayed at our Houses two months straight during daily radiation treatments at the University of Kansas Medical Center.

Chevi completed her treatment plan last summer, but 5 months later her aggressive cancer started growing back. Chevi had to return to Ronald McDonald House again in February to have radiation treatments.

"I can't even explain to someone who hasn't been through something like this how much Ronald McDonald House actually helps," says Destiny. "Even the little activities they have when she's having a bad day or things just aren't going well, she gets excited for them and you forget for just a second just how bad things are. It's just been great."

Chevi reached no evidence of disease this March and rang the bell at the hospital to celebrate! She and her family will return to check her progress every three months, but are happy to get back to Green Ridge and enjoy springtime at home.

If you've collected items, they can be delivered to the Longfellow House (2502 Cherry St, KC MO) between the hours of 7am -7pm daily.

In order to keep everyone safe during these times, we ask that you leave donations on the table outside and text us at 816-239-5759 or ring the doorbell to let us know you've arrived. Staff will come out to retrieve the items. There is no entry from outside visitors due to Covid-19 restrictions at this time.
